- 2. Timely for August WSC to create an ISR (Registration deadline is July 26th. We would need to raise \$200 and elect an ISR in June if we want to do this.)
- 3. Central place for literature and support to WSC from BDA
- 4. Central place to have PRG contacts and sponsoring for BDA
- 5. Central place to look for BDA centric meetings
- 6. Also events ... easy place to look on the web/search
- 7. Another way to do PI for attracting both DA and BDA members
- 8. Clearer leadership to offer help to newcomers, members, groups, and so forth
- 9. Central website doing coordination (like DATIG for the telephone groups)

Cons against creating a BDA Intergroup now

- 1. Does create a need for additional service
- 2. Confusion about "mutual representation" between local IG and this BDA IG
- 3. If DA is "whole" why would we have 2 Intergroups?
- 4. Are we "moving too fast"?
